RE: Senate Bill 1349 (Hertzberg) – Cal-Access Modernization – SUPPORT

Dear Chair Allen,

The undersigned organizations write to support Senate Bill 1349, which would direct the Secretary of State to modernize Cal-Access, California's online system for campaign finance filing and disclosure. This necessary upgrade would make the system more reliable, better inform voters, and simplify compliance by campaigns. Modernizing Cal-Access would increase the transparency of campaign financing without requiring new disclosure rules, simply by providing easier public access to the information that campaigns already report.

Since 2000, state candidates and political committees have submitted required filings through Cal-Access for online compliance and public access. At that time, Cal-Access was an early leader in electronic filing for campaign finance disclosure and set a national standard for online transparency. However, today the system is 16 years old and needs to be upgraded with modern capabilities. Currently, Cal-Access is not user-friendly for public access to information, filing is cumbersome, and the antiquated technology is difficult to maintain or modify.

SB 1349 would address these issues by updating Cal-Access. This legislation would give the Secretary of State the direction and resources necessary to bring Cal-Access into the 21st century.

Voters deserve ready access to campaign finance information, and a modern Cal-Access will help voters to make informed choices about state ballot measures and candidates.
