

Endorsement Form for AB 1217, Issue Ad DISCLOSE Act

The *California DISCLOSE Act* requires ballot measure ads and SuperPAC ads that attack or support candidates to clearly show their top 3 funders. But lobbying issue ads that pressure legislators to vote the way special interests want don't have to show their funders, nor do sham issue ads that attack candidates without "expressly" saying how to vote. AB 1217 extends the *California DISCLOSE Act* to cover:

- **Issue Advocacy Advertisements** that refer to pending legislative actions, administrative actions, or ballot measures, and either appeal for ad recipients to take action by contacting an elected official or are made within 60 days of the legislative session end.
- **Electioneering Communications** that refer to one or more candidates in the period between 90 days before the primary to the general election without "expressly advocating" for or against them.
