SB 636, the Ballot DISCLOSE Act

Show voters who supports and opposes
ballot measures on the ballot itself!

26	REQUIRES THAT CERTAIN STATE AND LOCAL FEES BE APPROVED BY TWO-THIRDS VOTE. FEES INCLUDE THOSE THAT ADDRESS ADVERSE IMPACTS ON SOCIETY OR THE ENVIRONMENT CAUSED BY THE FEE-PAYER'S BUSINESS. INITIATIVE CONSTITUTIONAL AMENDMENT. Fiscal Impact: Depending on decisions by governing bodies and voters, decreased state and local government revenues and spending (up to billions of dollars annually). Increased transportation spending and state General Fund costs (\$1 billion annually). Supporters: California Taxpayers' Association, California Chamber of Commerce, Small Business Action Committee, Nisei Farmers League. Clean Money Signatures Matter!

These nation-leading bills became law after tens of thousands of Californians signed paper California Clean Money Campaign petitions just like this one.

California DISCLOSE Act (AB 249) in 2017: The first law in the nation to require political ads to clearly show their top 3 true funders! You saw it in action last year!

Social Media DISCLOSE Act (AB 2188) in 2018: The first law in the nation to require Facebook, Twitter, Google etc. to clearly show the top 3 funders of political ads!

Petition DISCLOSE Act (SB 47) in 2019: The first law in the nation to require initiative signature gatherers to show voters the top 3 funders of the signature-gathering effort!

Text Message DISCLOSE Act (AB 201) in 2019: The first law in the nation to require unsolicited political texts to clearly show who paid for them!
