

Voters' Right to Know Act & AB 700, California DISCLOSE Act **Endorsement Form**

AB 700, the California DISCLOSE Act, and the Voters' Right to Know Act are measures that will dramatically improve campaign finance disclosure, making California a national model of reform.

AB 700 is a bill by Assemblymembers Jimmy Gomez and Marc Levine. Sponsored by California Clean Money Campaign.

The Voters' Right to Know Act is a statewide initiative for the November 2016 ballot. Sponsored by Californians for the Right to Know and authored in part by Bob Stern, coauthor of the Political Reform Act of 1974.

AB 700 and the Voters' Right to Know Act both require political ads to clearly show their top three true funders. Both apply to ads about state and local ballot measures and ads about candidates paid for by outside groups.

The Voters' Right to Know Act also:

- Establishes a California constitutional right to know the true sources of political spending.
- Provides \$13 million to revamp the state's donor database, completely bans gifts to legislators from lobbyists and their employers, and restricts revolving-door job offers to elected officials for two years.

Businesses Endorse AB 700, the *California DISCLOSE Act*

Two-thirds of business leaders believe secret political spending poses a threat to companies.* We need to make sure that the voices of small businesses aren't drowned out by deceptive ads paid for by giant special interests hiding behind misleading names.

That's why we need AB 700 (Gomez-Levine), the *California DISCLOSE Act*, to stop big secret spending in California by letting voters know who *really* pays for ballot measure ads. It will:

- Require the top three funders of state and local ballot measure ads to be shown clearly and unambiguously on the ads themselves.
- Require funders disclosed on ballot measure ads to be the original sources of the contributions to the committee that paid for the ad, even if funders try to hide behind multiple layers of committees or organizations.
