The Voters' Right to Know Act is a statewide initiative for the November 2016 ballot that will dramatically improve campaign finance disclosure, making California a national model of reform.

- Requires ads on state and local ballot measures and ads about candidates paid for by outside groups to clearly show their top three funders even if they send funds through multiple layers of organizations.
- Establishes a California constitutional right to know the true sources of political spending.
- Completely bans gifts to legislators from lobbyists and their employers, and restricts revolving-door job offers to elected officials for two years.
